



The academic advisor for a group of students is the staff member in charge of their PBL sessions







- 1. The academic advisor does **not have the authority** to make decisions, but he has to present many possible solutions to the student's problem.
- 2. The academic advisor is **not expected to raise** the level of the student, but he can encourage the student to make the maximum use of the capabilities he possesses.





3. It is **not permissible** for the academic advisor to **criticize** one of his fellow **faculty members** in front of students even if the faculty member was a part of the student's problem.

4. The academic advisor should not criticize the student, but he can point to matters in which the student appears weak or strong, aiming to raise the student's level.





5. The academic advisor should not let down the confidence of the student in matters of his personal nature, but he may request appropriate professional assistance to help the student suffering from personal or social adjustment.




